



Autonomous University of Barcelona: One-Year Study

The Autonomous University of Barcelona conducted a one-year study of JUMP Math with 1000 grade 5 students. Before JUMP, the average score of the students on a standardized test of mathematical knowledge was 3.1 points out of ten. After a year of JUMP, the average score was 5.2 points. 85% of the students improved their scores on the test. Teachers and parents rated the improvement in students' attitudes about math to be medium to high. Many teachers were impressed by the progress their students made. For example, one teacher said: "I have a girl with very serious emotional problems who was a 1 and was very unmotivated. Now she is a 4. A 4 was unthinkable, it was unthinkable."
