JUMP Math is an [award-winning](#) charity founded in 2002 by Dr. John Mighton. Based in Toronto, JUMP Math's elementary-level math resources (K-8) are used across Canada, the US, and several European countries.

We believe that everyone can be great at mathematics. We empower educators and students with research-informed, curriculum-aligned print and technology

resources and approaches that instill confidence and spark a life-long love of mathematics. We engage and collaborate with those advancing education around the world to foster human potential and well-being.

In Fiscal Year 2019-2020, our program reached 180,000 students in Canada, including 15% of all elementary students learning in remote Indigenous communities.

RESPONDING TO THE PANDEMIC

With the arrival of COVID-19 and nation-wide closures in March 2020, schools suddenly shifted to a remote learning model. JUMP Math moved quickly to help teachers and students adapt. In addition to countless hours of email and phone support, our team provided a range of free resources:

- Essential lesson guides to maximize learning time (by grade/province);
- Professional development webinars, which attracted 1,000+ registrants;
- September primers with key lesson resources from the previous grade.



