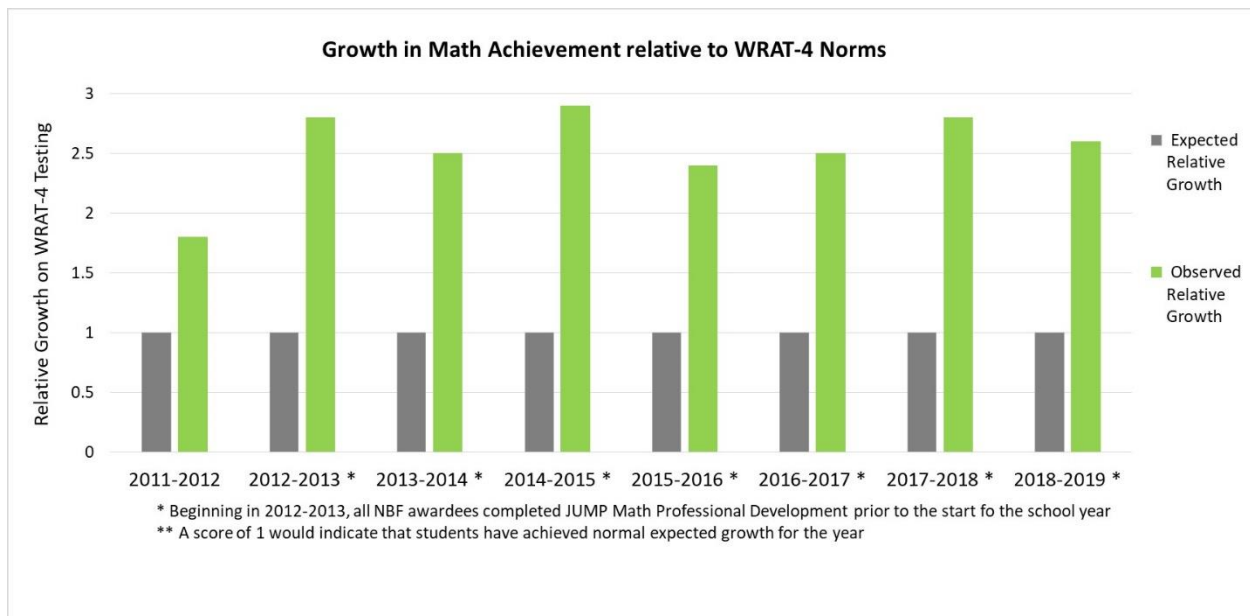




## JUMP Math National Book Fund School Studies:

The National Book Fund awards free JUMP Math resources to classrooms across Canada. This report was generously funded through the support of TD Bank Group, who was lead sponsor of the program from 2013-2020.

The reports show that for the past seven years in a row, the growth in math achievement in JUMP Math students grew at a minimum of 2.4 times the rate of the WRAT-4 norms.



In the 2018-2019 school year, a total of 256 students in grades 4-7 completed the math computation subtest of the WRAT-4 in the fall and spring. Here are the highlights:

- On average, math achievement of students grew at 2.6 times the rate of the WRAT-4 standardization sample
- The percentage of students scoring 'average' or above increased from 50% in the fall to 60% in the spring
- The percentage of students scoring 'above average' or higher increased from 4% in the fall to 12% in the spring.
